Reduce the Carbon Footprint of the Business

- Staff drive electric vehicles
- Minimise travel by maximising IT systems
- Car share where possible
- Strict control and adherence to EC Regulation 284/2006

Reduce Energy Consumption

- Ensuring all electric consuming items are switched off when not in use
- Lights switched off when not in use
- Communal areas have sensors to detect movement when needed, preventing unnecessary energy consumption
- Windows are opened in summer to reduce A/C usage
- All heating/cooling apparatus on timers

Minimise the Production of all types of Waste

- We use recycled materials from deliveries boxes and bubble wrap
- Recycled paper used if printing (kept to a minimum)
- All the printer/scanners switch to standby mode when not in use
- All floors within head office have food waste, general waste and recycling bins
- Managing and disposing of all waste in a responsible manner
- Pollution is prevented in all forms, whilst protecting the flora/fauna, land air and water within the office boundaries
- Ensuring all water is used efficiently
- Used batteries are disposed of in battery bins in the local supermarket
